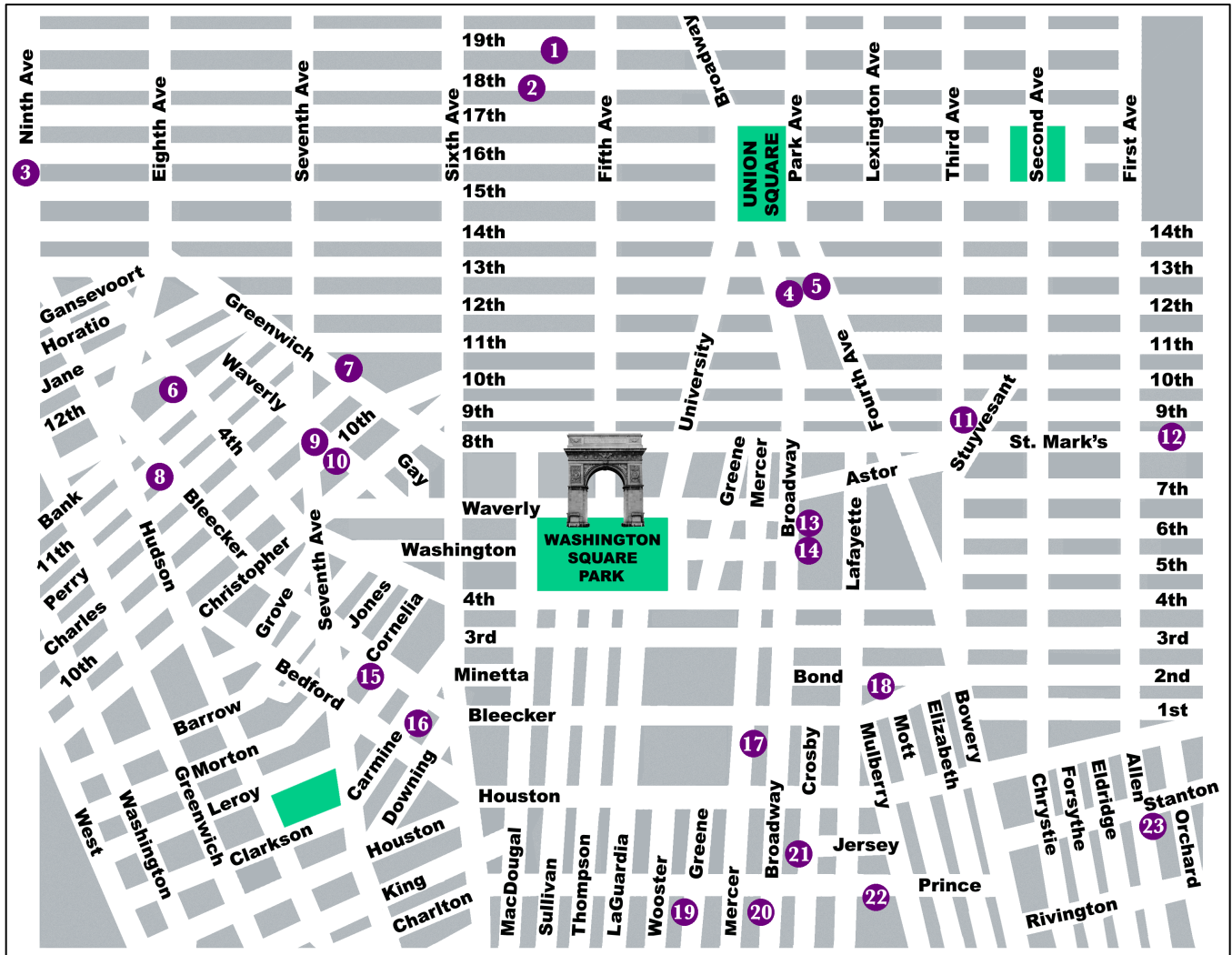


GREENWICH VILLAGE BOOKSTORE ADVENTURE

1. IDLEWILD BOOKSHOP
12 W. 19th St.
Specializes in travel and international literature. Carries guidebooks from 100 countries and all 50 states, as well as a selection of fiction and non-fiction, all shelved together by country. *Opens at 12.*

2. BOOKS OF WONDER
18 W. 18th St.
New York's premiere children's bookstore. Well-stocked with new, old and out-of-print children's books, as well as first editions and rare titles. Authors

visit often for the storytelling program. Café and restrooms. *Opens at 10.*

3. POSMAN BOOKS AT CHELSEA MARKET
75 Ninth Ave.
The intimacy of a mom-and-pop store but with big-city energy. Located in Chelsea Market, a shopping mall and food court in the former factory where the Oreo cookie was born. The market serves as the locale for the Food Network shows "Iron Chef America" and "Emeril Live." *Opens at 10.*

4. STRAND BOOKSTORE
828 Broadway
A must-see! This world-famous bookstore carries over 2.5 million used, out-of-print, rare and first-edition books on 18 miles of shelf space. Restrooms. *Opens at 9:30.*

5. ALABASTER BOOKSHOP
122 Fourth Ave.
A small East Village treasure with a wide variety, from poetry and the classics to architecture and science fiction. Has the feel of a neighbor's private library. *Opens at 10.*

6. LEFT BANK BOOKS

304 W. 4th St.

Used and rare books in good condition. A nice respite in the West Village. An excellent place to browse. *Opens at 11.*

7. PARTNERS & CRIME

44 Greenwich Ave.

A casual shop specializing in mysteries. Could pass for a well-stocked living room. Well-known mystery writers often visit for signings and readings. *Opens at 12.*

8. BOOKMARC

400 Bleecker St.

An eclectic shop owned by fashion designer Marc Jacobs. Mainly carries art, photography and coffee table books. Directly across from the famous Magnolia Bakery. *Opens at 11.*

9. BONNIE SLOTNICK COOKBOOKS

163 W. 10th St.

A tiny, unique store specializing in out-of-print and antiquarian cookbooks from all over the world. Bonnie has been profiled on NPR and in *USA Today* and the *New Yorker*. *Opens at 12.*

10. THREE LIVES & COMPANY

154 W. 10th St.

A small Greenwich Village institution with a gigantic literary reputation. Many of the city's top writers, agents, editors and publishers shop here. The variety is tremendous, and the booksellers are very knowledgeable. Browsing is encouraged. *Opens at 11.*

11. ST. MARK'S BOOKSHOP

31 Third Ave.

An eclectic, spacious East Village bookstore, it features a fantastic selection of fiction, philosophy, art, graphic design, cultural and critical theory books, plus small-press literary and alternative magazines. *Opens at 10.*

12. EAST VILLAGE BOOKS

99 St. Mark's Place

Used books. Interesting selection and reasonable prices. Definitely worth a look. *Opens at 12.*

13. NEW YORK UNIVERSITY BOOK CENTER

726 Broadway

Serves the NYU community and beyond. Over 40,000 books in stock, including textbooks, academic works and popular titles. *Opens at 10.*

14. SHAKESPEARE & CO.

716 Broadway

An intimate bookshop with a collection equal to any chain store. Great selection of art, theatre, film, and crime books. Be sure to check out the basement, too. The variety is amazing. *Opens at 12.*

15. BOOKBOOK

266 Bleecker St.

A small, quiet, eclectic shop, recently opened, with nice variety, lots of discounted books and great staff. A browser's favorite. *Opens at 11.*

16. UNOPPRESSIVE NON-IMPERIALISTIC BOOKS

34 Carmine St.

This cramped little beehive of a bookstore carries well-chosen publishers' overstock at bargain prices. Wide selection. *Opens at 11.*

17. MERCER STREET BOOKS

206 Mercer St.

Used books and textbooks. Great selection. Excellent history, philosophy and politics sections. Don't skip the books piled on the floor! *Opens at 10.*

18. DASHWOOD BOOKS

33 Bond St.

New York City's only independent bookstore devoted entirely to photography. Global selection, knowledgeable staff. A favorite with photographers and artists far and wide. *Opens at 12.*

19. TASCHEN BOOKSTORE

107 Greene St.

Retail location for art books published by Taschen. Large selection of affordable and interesting art, architecture, design and photography books. Friendly staff. *Opens at 11.*

20. SCHOLASTIC STORE

557 Broadway

Located in Scholastic's worldwide headquarters. A unique space with books, learning products, an activity loft and interactive events with author readings and character visits. Nostalgic yet modern. Parents and kids love it. *Opens at 10.*

21. HOUSING WORKS BOOKSTORE CAFÉ

126 Crosby St.

The profits go to Housing Works, an organization that provides housing, health care and support services for homeless people living with HIV & AIDS. The *Times* called the shop "a comfortable, down-to-earth place" and "one of the hottest literary hubs in New York." Café and restrooms. *Opens at 10.*

22. MCNALLY JACKSON BOOKS

52 Prince St.

When this store opened a few years ago, the headline in the *Times* read, "Defiant Newcomer Hopes Small Booksellers Still Have a Place." Since then it's become a downtown institution. Café and restrooms. *Opens at 10.*

23. BLUESTOCKINGS

172 Allen St.

A bookstore, café and activist center rolled into one. Specializes in gay, lesbian, feminism, politics and cultural studies. Hosts readings, workshops, performances, discussions and films almost every night. *Opens at 11.*
